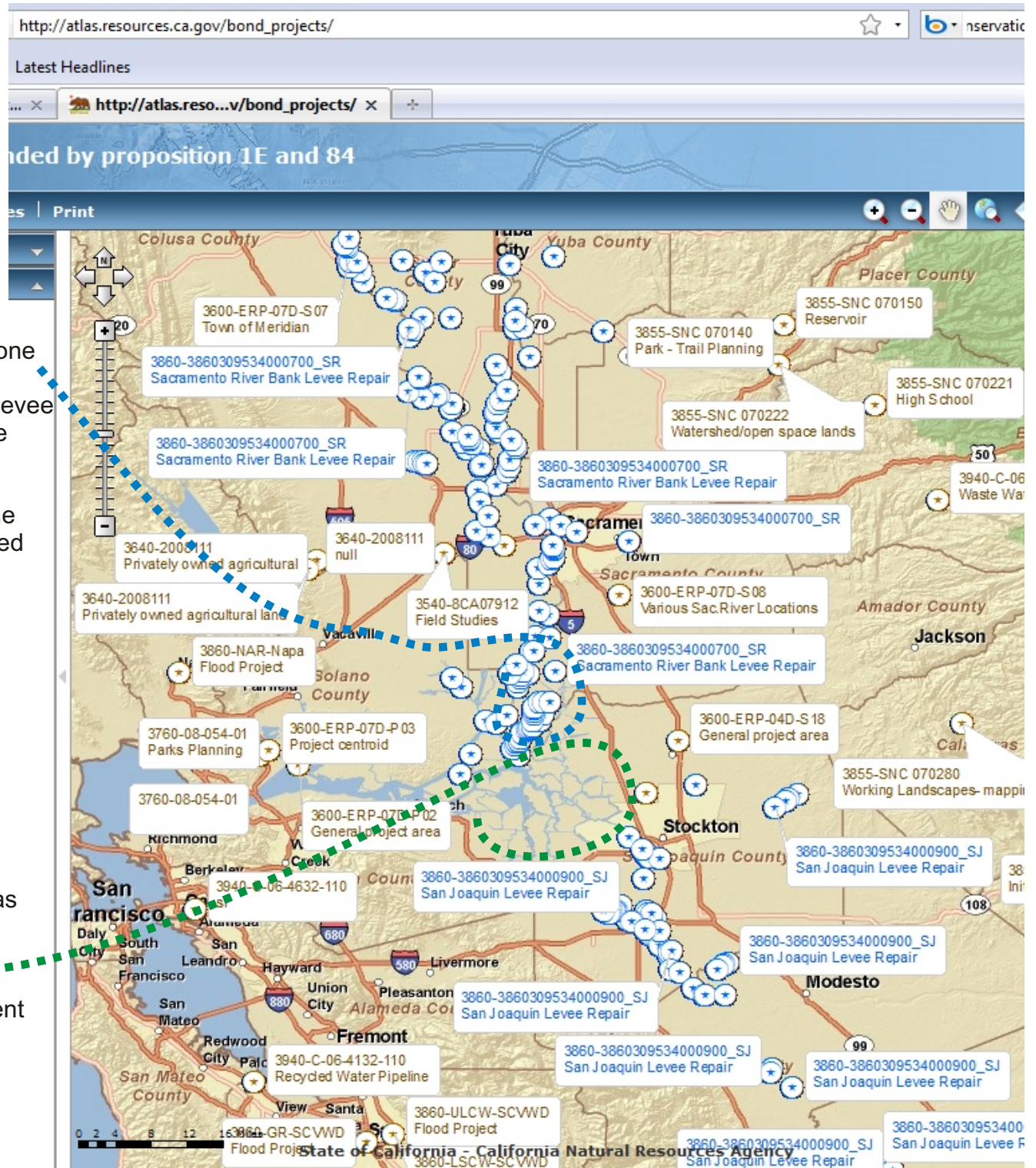


IN-Delta Storage Preparation

When one reviews how much money has gone into “repairs” to one side of Staten Island, it is clear Staten is the focus of most of the levee repair funds over the last few years. But the unusual situation is that Georgiana Slough does not get that much water annually so there should not be much pressure on the levees. Of course, if the repairs are designed to keep water INSIDE STATEN ISLAND, which was purchased for \$35,000,000 to be used for “in-delta” storage, this might make more sense to expend funds here. Staten Island is under the management of the Nature Conservancy as of 2010.

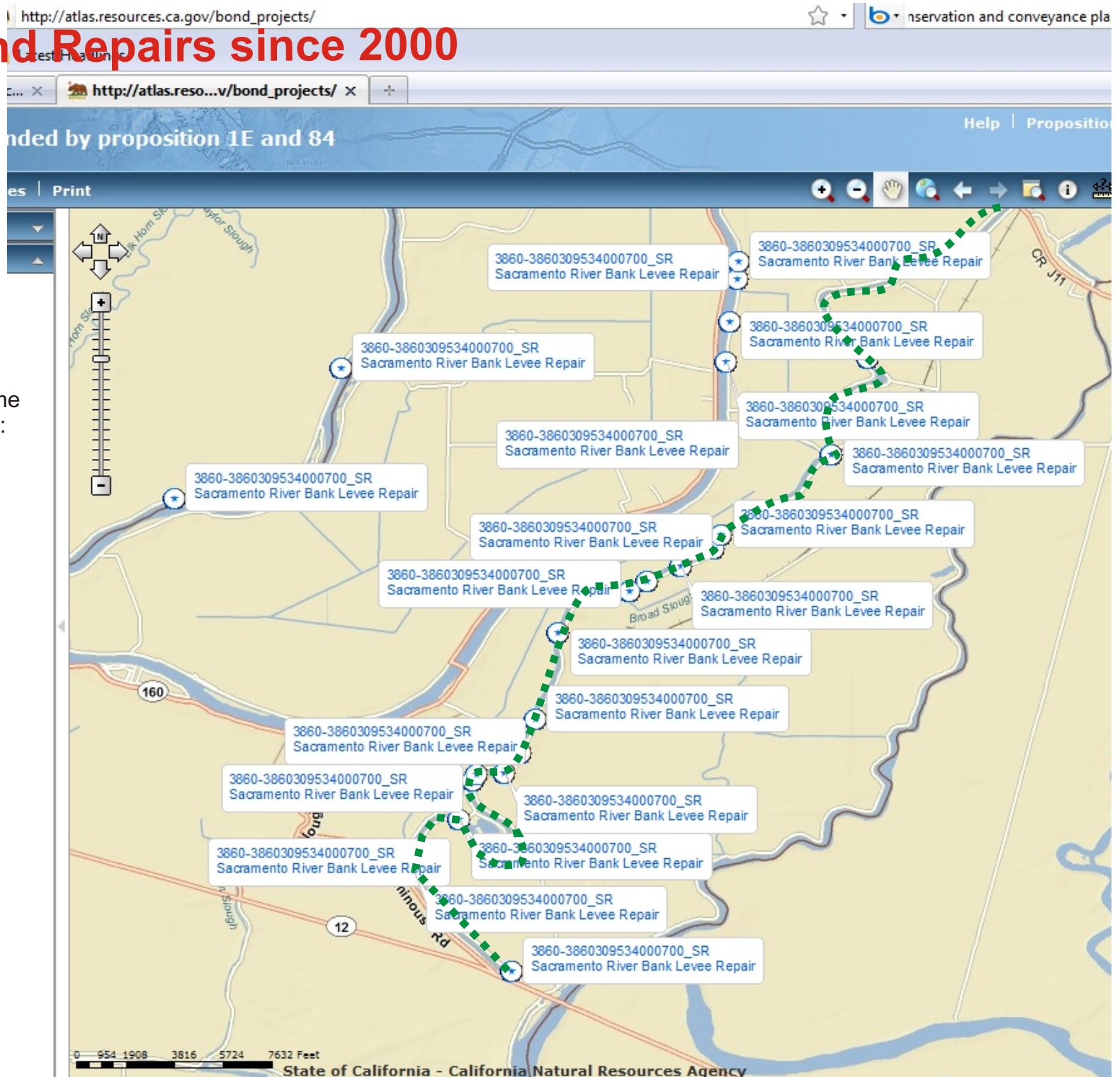
Another interesting item to note is the areas where you see NO repairs....
